

Project History: Hospital Restrooms North Carolina



The Problem

Hospital management required a cost effective solution for their restroom areas. The existing ceramic tile floor and walls were old, dirty with a significant grout odor problem! As part of a major upgrade they wanted to make the floors and walls safe and hygienic for the patients and make sure the surfaces were easy to maintain. However with over 300 restrooms needing refurbishment the cost to rip up an replace was proving to be very expensive and time consuming.

The Solution

CoverTec offered a tough durable floor and wall coating system that could be applied over the top of the existing without the need for rip out. The CoverFlake system (with E900 base coat and P650 fast dry top coat) was applied on the floor. A custom colored GlazeGuard was applied to the walls. The surfaces were cleaned and prepared with PreTreat prior to spraying GlazeGuard using a LVLP cup gun (1 mist coat and 2 heavier coats, consecutively)

All products used, were water based and low odor, easily meeting indoor air quality IAQ criteria.
